Adding Lowe's Import Data

Import vendors are able to use the Syndigo CES platform to share import specific data with Lowe's as part of the item setup process.

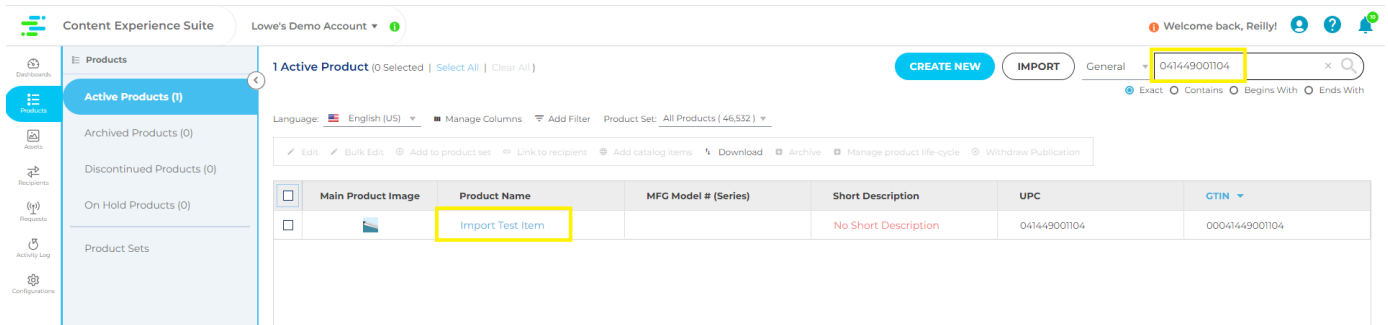
1. As you add your product(s) in the CES platform and populate the Lowe's Core & Enrichment requirement set, you will notice the attribute titled **"Will the product ship to Lowe's Domestic or Import?"**
2. Select **Import** from the following choices for **"Will the product ship to Lowe's Domestic or Import?"**
 - **Import** – Items shipped via an international mode of transportation, where Lowe's Global Sourcing will be the importer of record.
 - **Domestic** – Items that are not considered import products.
3. Once **Import** is selected, the appropriate Import attributes will become required within the requirement set.
 - Please note, if **"Import"** is selected, **"Will Lowe's Global Sourcing be the imported of record?"**, must be **"Yes"**
 - Populate the required attributes.
4. Once your **Readiness Score** reaches 100%, you have satisfied all the required attributes in this requirement set. You must then **Publish** your changes so that they can be received by Lowe's.

NOTE: Please note, Shipping Port Description (name) needs to match with corresponding Shipping Port Description (code)

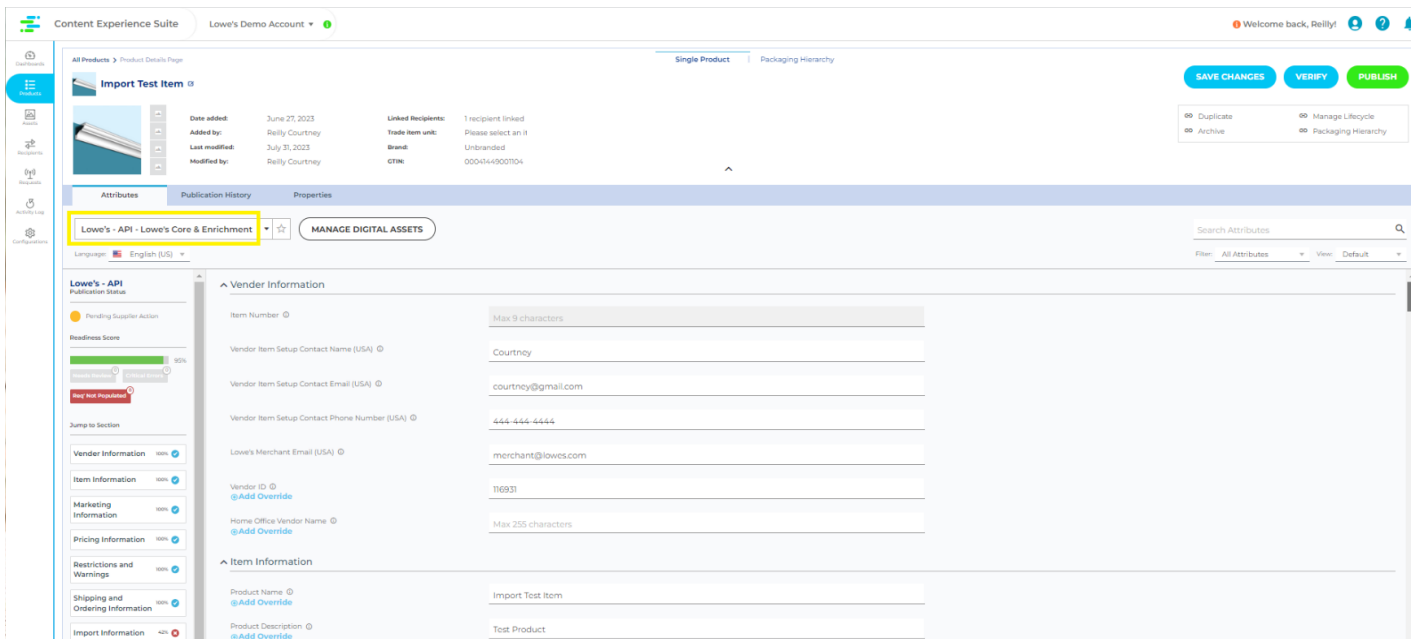
Adding Lowe's Import Data

Step-By-Step Screenshots:

Locate an existing product by searching for the UPC or other identifier, and click the Product Name to bring the product into single item edit mode:



Once in single item edit mode, select the Lowe's – API- Lowe's Core & Enrichment requirement set:

Select the appropriate value for “Will the product ship to Lowe’s Domestic or Import?”, in this example ‘Import’:

Adding Lowe's Import Data

Please note, within the **"Import Information"** section, there are some conditionally required attributes. For example, if "Does this item include any textile materials?" is "Yes", then the following attributes highlighted in red below become required:

Adding Lowe's Import Data

When the required attributes have been completed and the Readiness Score reaches 100%, Publish the information to Lowe's – API:
