2 STEPS TO BEGIN SYNCING YOUR DATA WITH PEPPER

- If you are not a member yet, consider subscribing to a GDSN-certified data pool like 1WorldSync by Syndigo. For more information, you can reach out to 1WorldSync by Syndigo to get more information.
 - Education/Training from your data pool or solution provider.

2. Load items into your data pool
- Ensure your data is accurate (pack quantities, measurements, weights etc.)
 - Load all item levels in your packaging configuration (hierarchy) – Each, Case, & Pallet
 - Review attribute requirements in Section 3 of this document to ensure you can meet Pepper requirements.
3. Complete the Pepper Trading Partner form for a subscription request. [Click here](#) to visit the Pepper landing page.
4. Pepper will create a subscription based on your Information Provider GLN and notify you when complete.
5. Publish your existing and/or new items to Pepper (Pepper GLN# 0860010615713) in the Production environment of your GDSN data pool.
6. Manage Catalogue Item Confirmation (CIC) Responses from Pepper
- CIC with state of "ACCEPT" means that Pepper has received your data, but no business decision has been made on the data.
 - CIC with state of "REVIEW" means that Pepper is asking you look over your data due to discrepant data they cannot synchronize on.
 - CIC with state of "SYNCHRONIZE" means that Pepper has integrated your data with their backend systems.
 - CIC with state of "REJECT" means that Pepper did not accept your data.
 - **Note:** Pepper is using the CIC status details. This will give you clarification on what is discrepant with your data.

7. Send ongoing item maintenance notifications through your GDSN Certified Data Pool to the Pepper GLN.

3 ATTRIBUTE REQUIREMENTS

We request vendors to publish:

- I. Mandatory attributes by GDSN to ensure quality and completeness. Additionally include for all your food service items:
 - a. Core supply chain data
 - b. Marketing data including Product Title, Feature Benefits and Product Images
 - c. Nutritional, Ingredient and Allergen data
 - d. Any additional foodservice industry requires attributes that will help consumers learn about your product.
